JOSEPH TEACHES US ABOUT FATHERHOOD

It wasn't the seed of Joseph that was planted in Mary's womb, but when that baby was born; when Herod sent soldiers to murder Him; when the family had to flee the country; when they made the long journey home; when they needed a roof over their heads and sandals on their feet and food on their table, Joseph was the man to get it done. Joseph was not the father of Jesus, but then again, he was the father of Jesus. Jesus was the true offspring of the heavenly Father, very God of very God, begotten not made, but even the Son of God needed a daddy.

Joseph is God's way of reminding us that fatherhood is not a hobby but a *vocation*—a calling that is both sacred and life-encompassing. God hallows fatherhood, makes it holy, something that is set apart and special to Him. For in it He both conceals and reveals His own fatherhood to us. As Joseph protected his family, led them, worked for them, cared for them, taught them, he was but a mask for the Father in heaven who used Joseph as His hands and feet and mouth to care for the Savior and His mother. Every father fails at times. And God forgives! He covers our weaknesses with the cloak of His grace! He continues to use us as His masks to care for those whom He has placed in our care.

Above all, we teach them at home, in the car, wherever we might be, about the Father who loves them so much that He sent His own Son to be born into a human family, to live and to die and to rise again, that they might receive the gifts of life and salvation.

Fathers, we are all Joseph—all masks of the heavenly Father by which He cares for the children He has given to us.
